- A. Such evaluation should be performed for the Commission by subcommittees and task forces appointed for that purpose under criteria adopted for groups functioning in an advisory capacity.
- B. Such formal evaluation should not prevent the Commission from encouraging interested persons and organizations to advise that body on a regular basis on any matter affecting the interests of better education.
- C. All rules and regulations affecting the education, certification, and accreditation process under the jurisdiction of the Commission should contain provisions for self-evaluation and feedback for the benefit of the institutions involved in the process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS DOCUMENT RECEIVE AS WIDE A DISSEMINATION AS POSSIBLE, TO THE END THAT FERSONS CONCERNED WITH ITS EFFECTS SHALL BE AFFORDED THE OPPORTUNITY TO SUGGEST FUTURE REVISIONS OR METHODS OF IMPLEMENTATION.
